Facility maintenance - interviewing American Workforce employees to help with maintenance/setup. Jaime is here to see about possibly volunteering for the open Field Maintenance Manager. Jenn nominated Jaime Lara for the position, Trieste seconded, all in favor, motion approved.

New Business

Jeff made a motion to purchase new nets for full size goals, Cathy seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

Jeff would like to have a booth at the Go 4th festival. Jennifer made a motion to approve \$150 for the booth fee, Marv seconded, all in favor, motion passed.

We need to come to an agreement with the softball association for water lines. The agreement would be that anything within their boundaries is their responsibility, anything outside of their boundaries is LSC responsibility.

Cathy would like to store CYSA paperwork in a secure location. It was agreed that it can be stored in the equipment room.

Marv requested the use of the parking lot/covered area for a fundraiser yard sale.

Jim Maggs inquired about if LSC could do anything to improve Archie Anderson park so it would be more suitable for soccer. Jeff let him know that it's up to the Park's Department.

Jim suggested having a logo contest to encourage merchandise sales. It was agreed that it's a great idea. Looking for someone to spearhead it.

Jim suggested offering a reduction of fees for volunteer hours. If we had more volunteers we'd support moving ahead with this.

It was decided that we'll be participating in the Go 4th Cardboard Regata.
