Christie Maggs, Micro-ref

Jaime Lara, Facility Maintenance

Jak informed of the interest of R.D. Olson, a long time team sponsor, in donating time and/or materials for new bleachers and covers.

Longview Utilities is looking at putting up a meter gateway to do a usage study. Looking at putting up a light pole to hang the light and meter on. LSC would only be responsible for the electricity. It would also serve as one of the supports for the field 2 net.

Jenn Jolly, Equipment Manager

Found some old sponsor checks in the equipment room along with some cash. The cash covered the cost of the jerseys for those sponsored teams so no money was lost.

Looked into the bid from Athlete's Corner. They want 2-3 weeks notice, rush orders are extra, no late additions. They order in house and the printing is done in Vancouver. The shirts they presented were lesser quality for dry fit and see through. The t-shirt is lighter as well. Terri can get the lighter t-shirts and it would be a lesser cost. Jenn is going to get a final total cost comparison from Athlete's Corner.

Marv Kasemeier, Concessions
