Morgan Aberle, Timber Barons

Parent/coach meeting is scheduled 3/3 at the PUD building.

Tara Hargrave, Kalama

She has a verbal agreement with Kalama High School to use their field for the 2 older teams.

All other ages will play on Kelso fields.

Nicole Vazquez, Kelso

They will be working over the summer to update their bylaws and layout a 5 year plan.

Discussed that Kelso feels it's important for referees to report issues with coaches so they have a paper trail for disciplinary actions.

Received a couple of requests from Kelso coaches:

- A communication be sent to Vancouver reminding them of the rule that spectators sit on the opposite side of the field as the team.
- Coaches receive a phone call the night before their game if they aren't going to have any refs.

Nicole Vazquez, Registrar Committee

Teams have all been formed.

She is holding a training session on April 28th at the clubhouse to train registrars to open their own registrations.

Team Sports is presenting their registration software on March 22nd.

Discussed at length the decision making process that goes into when teams are sent to play in Vancouver.

Nicole will send an email to the Vancouver scheduler requesting the CYSA teams play each other at least once.

Jennifer Cockrill, Longview

The fields are still in rough shape and with the heavy rains, we aren't able to mow. The mower got stuck yesterday.

The coach's meeting is scheduled for March 10th.

Jeff Coleman is moving ahead with the High School Showcase.

Cathy Reynolds, Treasurer

Kalama and Kelso still need to send in year end financials so everything can be sent to the CPA.

There are still some Timber Baron players that owe and 8 full teams still need to submit year end statements and any monies left over to CYSA.

Don Sharer, CYSA

Implementing the new fee of \$2 per player to cover referee reimbursement (certification, recertification, uniform) and assignor costs. The money will be held at CYSA and paid out to refs based on number of games worked rather than to individual clubs. The fee may go down in later seasons.

The Coach Committee chair is Tyler Lee. All clubs need to have a liaison for the committee in place by July 15.

Old business

We need to work on the rule book. We'll have the May meeting be a work session with groups addressing areas of the rule book that apply to them.
